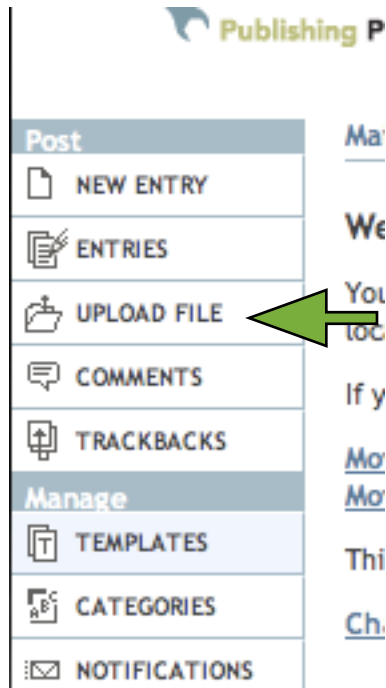


to embed an audio/video file in your blog:
(This means that you can listen/view the file online)

Have an idea of where and what you want to post to your blog. A small instructional film or a recording of you speaking text are good ways to utilize this process. This file can either be an audio file (I suggest an MP3) or a visual file (.swf or .mov are both suggested).



1: Select "Upload File" from the Moveable Type *left* toolbar.

2: The window that appears for uploading a file might have opened behind the original window as a small *pop-up* window. If a new window does not appear, try pressing "F10", this will show you all the windows that are open in the program, as long as they are not minimized. In the new window that appears, select "Choose File" to locate the file you are uploading from your computer. Once you have located the file and selected it, you must decide the appropriate path, "Local Archive Path". Now press the "upload" button.

To upload a file to your server, click on the browse button to locate the file on your hard drive.

You can upload the above file into either your Local Site Path (?) or your Local Archive Path (?). Or, you can upload the file into any directory beneath those directories, by specifying the path in the text boxes on the right (*images*, for example). If the directory does not exist, it will be created.

3: In the new window that opens, select "Create New Entry".

3: Enter your text as you would like it to appear in the window, preferably *above* the HTML code that was created for you (see the examples below). Don't forget to *Title* the entry and enter a *Primary Category*!

4a: Now that you have text entered, you must replace the code that was provided with a new line of code. Make special note of the text between the quotation marks, , a good idea is to COPY all of the information between the quotations, including the quotations.

example:

line of code shown:

```
<a href="http://username.blog.uvm.edu/eng001/archives/file.mp3">Download file</a>
```

piece of code (this information is called the *URL*) that we *need*:

```
"http://username.blog.uvm.edu/eng001/archives/file.mp3"
```

This piece is very important, do not forget this exact line, including quotations. A good idea is to COPY all of the information.

4b: Delete the existing code and in it's place insert the following, replacing the sample URL show with the URL you copied:

```

```
